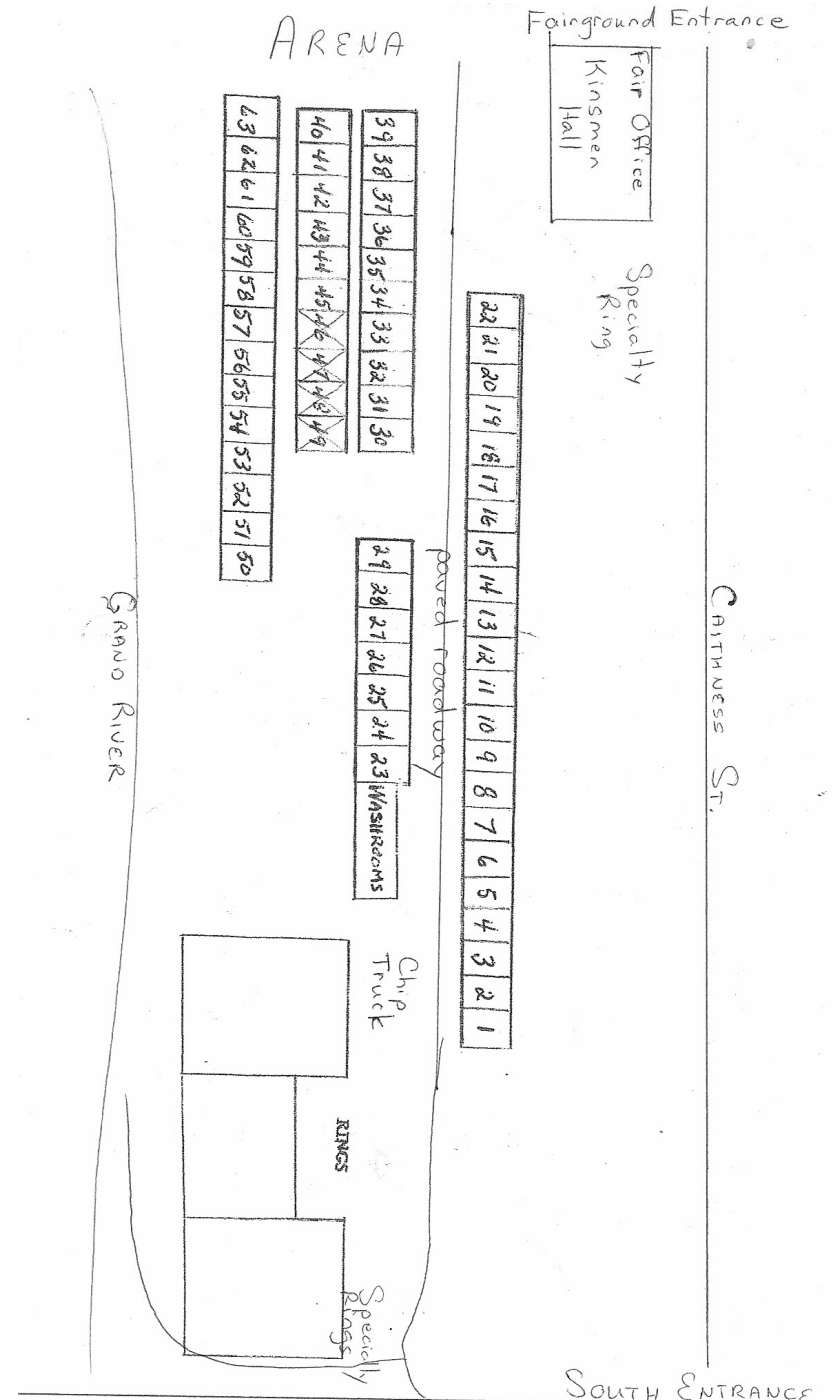

Our 2010 Judging Panel

Mr. Robert (Bob) Dawson is an Australian who has worked in the Asia and the Pacific region for nearly 30 years. He is currently a senior executive with the Asian Development Bank, a multilateral finance institution, with headquarters in Manila, Philippines, and, of which Australia is a member.

In dogs he has concentrated on Pugs, Boston Terriers, Miniature Dachshund, Basenji, and Bulldogs, breeding and campaigning many to their Philippine Grand Champions and Champions. He has also made-up AKC Champions in Basenjis, Pugs and Poodles. He is active in the show ring and has won a number of Best in Shows with his dogs. His kennel prefix is "Kawana".

Mr. Dawson has been a Director on the Board of the Philippine Canine Club Inc., (PCCI) the parent canine body in the Philippines and is a life member of that organization. For many years he was the Chair of the Affiliated Clubs Committee and the Judges' Committee, and was actively involved in the creation of breed and group clubs. He was a founding member of the Pug Club of the Philippines, the Boston Terrier Club of the Philippines, and the Hound Group Club of the Philippines, of which he was a former President.

Mr. Dawson judges all-breeds under the Philippine Canine Club Inc., list of breeds. He has judged on all six continents and holds all-breed status under both FCI and the Asian Kennel Union. He has judged extensively in Australia and New Zealand; South Africa, Brazil, several countries in Europe including Finland, Switzerland, Latvia, Ireland, Russia, Germany, England, and Sweden; in the United States and Canada, and in most of the countries in Asia including India, Thailand, Indonesia, Singapore, Malaysia, Republic of China, and Japan as well as in all of the major centers in the Philippines. He judges around 60 shows each year. He has officiated at many specialty shows, as well as Dog of the Year competitions in Australia, South Africa, Europe, and Asia.

Jaime Ganoza was born and lives in Lima Peru, graduating in 1971 as Industrial and Systems Engineer and has had dogs around he and his family his whole life. They share their lives with dogs from several breeds such as, German Shepherds, Papillion, Maltese, Yorkshire Terrier, and Pug amongst others

Jaime has been a breeder owner handler of Afghans Hounds since 1975. Since then he has had the privilege to produce more than 80 champions under the Dega Afghans and Chaman & Dega prefixes. As a breeder owner he has handled his Afghans all the way to win more than 70 BIS, in Peru and other countries.

The gene pool he used in his breeding program, allowed him to produce, in six generations of home bred dogs, champions in a dozen of countries throughout the Americas, from USA to Argentina. Many of these Champions became Group and BIS Winners at the national and international level. Internationally, his Afghans have won multiple BOB and Groups at FCI World Shows, a Best Bred By at a National Specialty in USA and an Award of Merit at Westminster .

Jaime has several times been a member of the Peruvian Kennel Club Board of Directors. He is currently Vice president of the KCP and member of the Judges Council and Genealogic Commission .He was part of the panel at the First Afghan Hound World Congress held in 1995 in San Diego and has been the delegate of his country at FCI and SICALAM Assemblies and the AKC Eukanuba National as well.

Jaime got his licence to judge Afghan Hounds in 1995 and All Breeds in 2002. Since then he has had the honour of judging Specialties and/or All Breed shows in USA, Canada, Mexico, Costa Rica, Puerto Rico, Honduras, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Colombia, Venezuela, Brazil, Argentina, Chile, Bolivia, Peru, Estonia, Sweden, Australia, Tasmania and New Zealand.

John L. Ronald and his wife, Kathy, have been showing dogs for more than 38 years. They have owned and bred many champion Samoyeds and Tibetan Terriers. Samoyeds have been part of his family since the late 1920s, and John is the fourth generation of his family to have owned and loved them. He is known for showing the top owner-handled Samoyed in US breed history, Am., Can., Bah. Ch. Polar Mist Dr. Pepper, BIS, BISS, ROM. He also owned the #1 Samoyed in 2002, CH Polar Mist My Blue Heaven, BIS, BISS.

Mr. Ronald also bred, showed and finished a number of Tibetan Terrier champions, including owner-handling CH Ti Song's Mr. Personality, BIS, ROM, to Best in Show, one of the first BIS for Tibetan Terriers.

He has been an AKC approved judge for the last 22 years. He judges the Working Group and half of the Non-Sporting Group, and Pyrenean Shepherds. He has also been the Delegate to the American Kennel Club for the Samoyed Club of America for the last 21 years. He has judged 3 U.S. Samoyed National Specialties and judged in England, Spain and Australia, China, and in Slovakia in conjunction with the 2009 World Dog Show.

Our 2010 Judging Panel

Elliott B. Weiss was born in New York City, Elliott Weiss grew up in the Catskill mountains of New York State. The very first show he attended was the 1956 Westminster Kennel Club Dog Show. It was love at first sight and in 1963 he became an exhibitor for the first time. Elliott worked as an apprentice handler to the Ted Young Jr. from 1965 through 1968 and became a licensed professional handler in 1969. In a 1985 poll held by KENNEL REVIEW magazine, the fancy voted Elliott among the top ten handlers at that time. He showed dogs professionally until the summer of 1993 including Betty Hyslops Terriers

During his life in dogs he has owned and bred, Cocker Spaniels, Clumber Spaniels, Giant Schnauzers, Pointers and English Setters. Elliott started judging in the summer of 1994 and is currently approved to judge the Sporting Group, Hound Group, Terrier Group, Non-Sporting group, thirteen Toy breeds, Giant Schnauzers and Bouviers des Flandres. He judged the Westminster Terrier Group in 2004 and the Sporting Group in 2008.

Prior to his re-locating to Idaho, he was a charter member and founding president of the Monticello New York Kennel Club.

He and his wife, Debra Mack, a veterinarian, live in Eagle Idaho. They own, exhibit and occasionally breed English Setters under the Wyndswept prefix.

Federico Fernandez of the Dominican Republic became involved in dog shows and related activities in the mid 1960's. Throughout the years in this sport he has been a handler and breeder of innumerable dogs. With the dogs he has bred there have been many championships accomplished in different areas of the Americas, including the United States. The dogs were always handled by he and his family.

As a handler he has had the opportunity to work with breeds he hasn't had the pleasure of breeding. However, completing their championships has been just as great a satisfaction as finishing the titles on the ones he bred.

As a judge he has had an FCI All Breed License (FCI/FCD) since 1992. He has specialized in Rottweilers, Pembroke Welsh Corgis, Miniature Pinschers, Pugs, Yorkshire Terriers, and Pointers.

Alongside his wife, Montserrat, and with the support of their children, they have the Montmar Kennels where, currently they have Pembroke Welsh Corgis, Miniature Pinschers, Pugs, Yorkshire Terriers, and Chihuahuas in both varieties. They have been focusing on these breeds for the past 18 years

Dr. Harry Smith interests in dogs started prior to World War II with his family's interest in Hunting dogs. Chesapeake Bay Retrievers were their first breed. He had no experience with AKC shows at the time. After the war and marriage, they bought a Pug from the Pugholm Kennel in Albany, New York. They showed her to her AKC championship and to her CD in obedience. She became the foundation bitch of their small kennel in Cincinnati, Ohio.

His activity in the Pug world was quite extensive. He co-founded the Pug Dog Club of Greater Cincinnati, was the delegate to the AKC for the National Pug Club for ten years. He owned and showed the first black pug to win the Pug Dog Club of America Futurity.

His judging career began in 1966 with Pugs. Over the next 33 years Harry progressed in the judging world until he was granted the Hound Group in 1999, when he was then recognized as an All-Breed Judge for the AKC.

During the 43 years that he has been judging, Harry has been honored to judge the Toy Group at Westminster, the Non-Sporting Group at the first AKC Invitational, and many other BIS throughout the world. He judged all the groups and the BIS at the Famous Welsh Kennel Club show in the United Kingdom, the Toy Group at the Xmas show in Stockholm, Sweden, BIS in Johannesburg, South Africa, and many others.

In October of 2006, the delegates of the AKC awarded Dr Smith the 2006 American Kennel Club Lifetime Achievement Award in the Category of Conformation.

Bill Hossler, a former navy man, has had dogs all his life with many of them being hunting dogs. He became interested in dog shows when his daughter-in-law began competing in the sport. Bill bought his first Samoyed over 20 years ago and under the Eis Baer prefix, Bill and his wife, Barb, bred and showed Samoyeds. Many of their dogs became champions and some were American and Canadian Champions. Bill also did some professional handling. In 1994 Bill and Barb purchased a Cavalier King Charles Spaniel. This is the breed they currently breed and show although they still have a 14 year old Samoyed called Xena.

In 2000, Bill commenced his judging career with Samoyeds being the first breed he was licensed to judge. Now he is very busy with judging assignments. He is quite interested in educating the public and fellow dog enthusiasts about breed characteristics. He just recently did a seminar for the Tonawanda Kennel Club comparing Cane Corsos and Dogue De Bordeaux. Bill is also very active in the Tonawanda Kennel Club where he is treasurer.

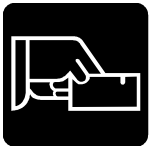

Linda More attended her first dog show – a benched show in Hartford, Connecticut – at age 11, and so began a lifelong love affair with dogs and the sport of purebred dogs. From beginning in obedience and juniors with her original breed, Shelties, to breeding and showing in conformation, she went on to a twenty year career as a professional handler in New England. Upon retiring from handling in 1991, Linda was granted approval to judge the Herding Group and Juniors, later adding Sporting breeds and then others. In 1997 she took a position as an AKC Field Rep, and then worked in the AKC's Operations Headquarters in Raleigh, NC. She retired from AKC and returned to judging in 2003, and at present judges the Herding, Sporting and Terrier Groups, a number of the Hound breeds, Siberian Huskies, Juniors and BIS. She is a Life Member of the American Shetland Sheepdog Association, for which she serves as the current judges education chair, and is a member of the German Shepherd Dog Club of America and three all-breed clubs. She is also on the board of the Dog Judges Association of America. Linda has three grown children and two grandchildren, and a Border Collie as a housedog

Lesley Hiltz started in the sport of Pure Bred dogs in Australia in 1967, with the purchase of a beagle.

This dog whilst not a great beagle was a great show dog, and was responsible for involving her in the sport. She subsequently purchased another beagle of better type and successfully showed him for a couple of years, before returning him to his breeder, as she was going to England on a working holiday for 2 years.

During her stay in England she purchased 2 beagles and showed them all over Britain

During her stay in England and through her association with Thelma Gray she became involved with Corgis, particularly Cardigan Corgis. When Lesley returned to Australia in 1972, she took 2 beagles with her and a Cardigan corgi, followed shortly afterwards.

Her main interest was always the Beagles however and over the years she was very successful in the show ring, with her breeding winning All Breed Best in shows, Specialty Best in shows, and many groups. Lesley showed and bred a few Cardigan litters and also helped friends by showing many Pembroke corgis over the years.

In 1988 Lesley moved to the USA and married her husband, David (a prominent Beagle breeder/owner/handler). I took 3 Australian Beagles with her and blended those into the American lines that her husband owned.

In the early 1990's Lesley & David added a couple of Whippets to their household and found out how much they enjoyed the breed.

In 1995 her husband took early retirement and they moved (with all our dogs) to Australia for 2 years. They took seven Beagles and the first 2 American whippets to go to Australia. These 2 Whippets changed the face of the breed in Australia (along with subsequent American imports by other people). In 1997 they returned to the USA, and settled in SW Washington State

Lesley and David no longer breed or show whippets and have just one veteran whippet bitch keeping the Beagles in order, but we still breed and show Beagles

Lesley's judging career started in Australia in 1974. Since moving to the USA she has been approved the AKC to judge the Hound, Herding, Non Sporting and Toy groups as well as 9 working breeds.

Lesley has been privileged to judge Beagle Specialties in Australia, Sweden, Norway, Germany, Mexico, Philippines and the Czech Republic, as well as the US. She has judged the National Specialties for both Beagles and Basenji in the US and she has judged Papillion's & Newfoundland Specialties in Denmark.

Lesley has judged at All breeds shows in Australia, England, Denmark, Italy, Taiwan & Sweden as well as the US & Canada.

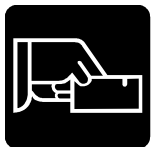
